2021- Student Council Report

In the month of January, two SASH representatives attended the IQAC meeting and were briefed about their role as student representatives in various committees.

Indoor sports event was conducted from 16th to 26th February where students participated in various events such as badminton, table tennis, carrom, chess, skipping and darts. Points for each game was given and the final scores were calculated with 2nd M.Sc's scoring the highest with points of 370 followed by 3rd B.Sc's with a score of 300 and so on.

The next event was Ethnic day, which was conducted on the 25th of February, and on this day students and staff adorned their ethnic wear and participated in various events such as Rangoli competition, fashion show and a spectacular dance performance by the M.Sc and B.Sc students, which was held in the auditorium, with the mask mandate in place. The winners of the fashion show and rangoli competition were also announced on the same day itself. The day ended on a sweet note as the students distributed sweets for everyone.

The students also actively participated in the World Hearing Day events conducted by the Department of Hearing Studies and Awareness Cell. They participated in events like Graffiti, Painting exhibitions and rallies to raise awareness on Hearing loss.

Students from 1st year and 3rd year BASLP participated in online competitions held by Bangalore North University Cultural fest. They participated in debate, mono acting and elocution and submitted their videos online by March 31st. The masters students conducted online mentoring sessions for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd B.Sc students to help guide them regarding academics and clinics and other issues during the pandemic period.
