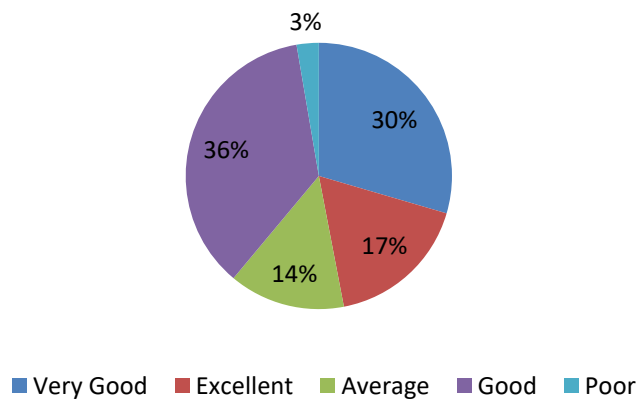
How do you rate the treatment of the students by the faculty?



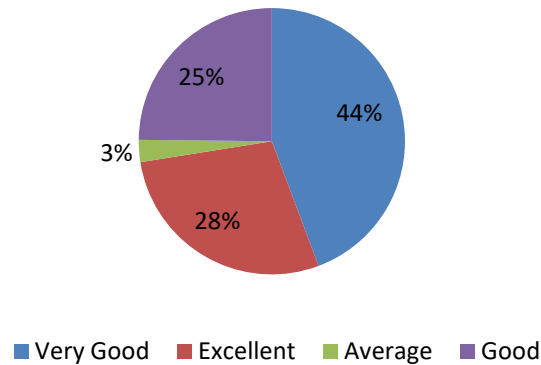
How do you rate the quality of teaching?

Analysis:

This report analyzes parent feedback data for the period September 2022 to August 2023. The feedback encompassed various questions, including the rating of the quality of library facilities at the college, the treatment of students by faculty, the quality of teaching, the transparency of the evaluation system in the college, and the assessment of the skills acquired by their sons/daughters from the course/subjects. The responses indicated varying opinions on different aspects by the parents. However, an overall positive sentiment was observed in the feedback, suggesting a generally favorable view of the college's performance.

Action Taken:

No negative remarks were obtained except very few parents expressing concerns about transparency of evaluation system. In response to the same, clear demarcations for Internal student ratings were made:

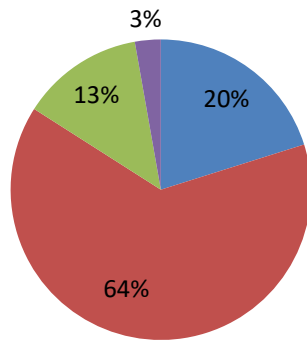


Was the entire syllabus covered by the Teacher?



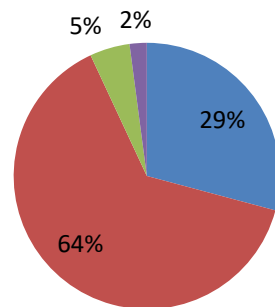
■ Most of the time ■ some of the time ■ seldom

Units in Syllabus are properly Sequenced.

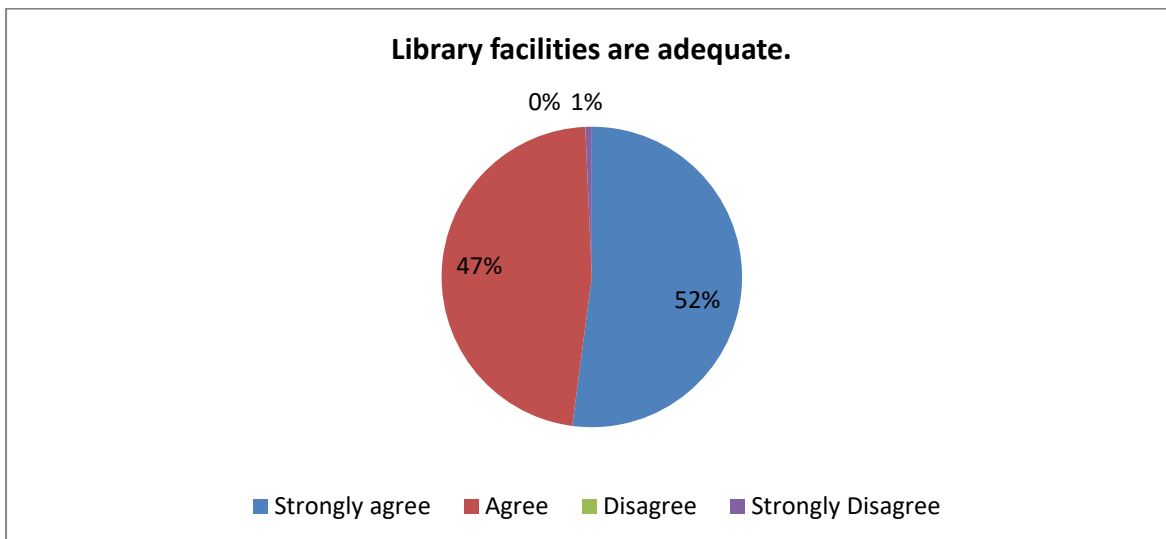

Analysis

This report analyzes student feedback of the batches enrolled between September 2022 to August 2023. The feedback addressed specific aspects of the course syllabus, covering several key dimensions. Students were asked to evaluate the appropriateness of the syllabus, the extent to which it was covered by the teacher, the sequencing of units within the syllabus, and whether it equipped them with the necessary technical skills for securing employment. Additionally, feedback was sought on the adequacy of library facilities. Despite the variations in students' perspectives on each aspect addressed in the feedback, an overall positive response was observed.

Action Taken for the feedback.

As most of the feedback is positive, no specific actions were warranted. However, a very few of them have expressed low ratings in aspects in terms of appropriateness of syllabus and teachers covering the entire syllabus. The suggestions were put forth in subsequent faculty meetings and were subjected to detailed deliberation. It was decided to follow LTP (Lecture, Tutorial and Practical) model to cover the entire syllabus effectively. Their lesson plans were also prepared accordingly to facilitate teaching as per LTP model. In addition to the above, Master Register entries were made mandatory to monitor progression in subjects and coverage of syllabus.

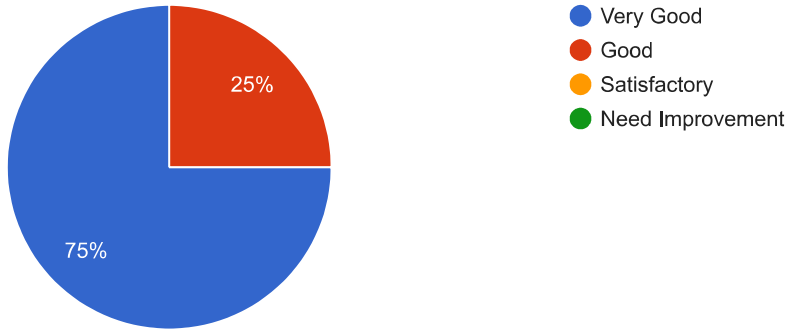

How do you rate the clinical competency level of our student(s) in relation to course content?



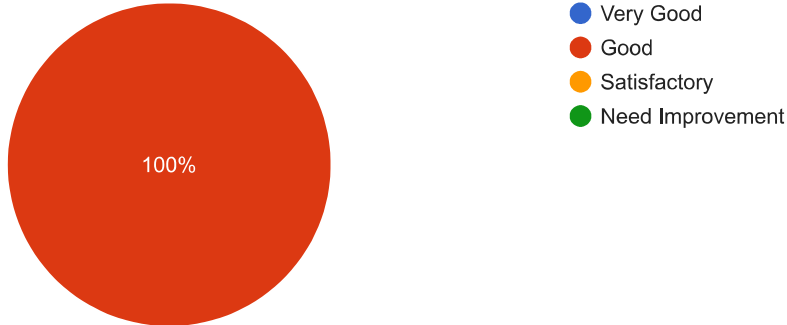
