Brief overview:



To increase the awareness of screen time and its impacts in children among parents

Brief Overview:

Ms. Prajna Kodgi (Asst. Prof, DSLS) conducted a talk on activities for "*The management of hyperactivity in children*". She also gave ideas on activities that are play oriented, and that can be done at home to improve pre linguistic behaviours in children. Insights on how to use materials that are easily available in the household in order to create simple yet effective materials for therapy were also discussed.

To build awareness on three core aspects of learning any behaviour which include antecedent, behaviour and consequences


Brief Overview:

The Parent Support Network (PSN) of the Department of Speech Language Studies conducted a meeting on 23/06/23. **Ms. Deborah Athaide** (Assistant Professor, Department of Speech Language Studies) spoke about the 'ABC's of Behaviour'.

She touched upon topics like what behaviour is, why it occurs and how undesirable behaviours can be modified to desirable ones. Real life scenarios and examples were given so that the parents could ponder upon them and analyse the antecedent, behaviour and consequence in each scenario. After the presentation, the session was open to discussion so that the parents could share their own experiences of handling undesirable behaviours.

Dr. Anita Reddy (Head of the Department of Speech Language Studies), addressed parents at the end of the session and asked for their opinion on enhancing the talents of children with communication disorders. Parents were enthusiastic and were willing to contribute their time for this initiative.

Feedback: At the end of the session feedback was collected from the parents regarding the program. All parents identified this to be a helpful discussion and of utmost relevance and expressed a need for future sessions on topics related to screen time management.

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Student Council Activity with Make A Better Place (NGO):<u>Clothes Donation</u> <u>Drive</u>



Objective: The drive was aimed at collecting funds and distributing food to the needy.

Brief overview:

In view of the holy month of Ramadan, SASH in association with NSS conducted a donation drive.

"His Paradise for the Deserted" is a home located in Kamanahalli, where a nun runs a home for approximately 20 children and adults (aged 4months to 24years) who are from lower income family groups with special needs. These children are abandoned by their families, sometimes found in gutters and abandoned on the streets. All children are unable to speak or care for themselves and need constant care. This home is run by a selfless nun who bathes, clothes, feeds and protects these children. A visit to this NGO shows anyone who walks in what a lot of difference one dedicated human being can do with support from the community. A flyer was put out regarding information about the donation drive and collection boxes kept in different parts of the college (3- floor, 1- floor and ground floor, near the reception) for a week for items to be dropped by donors.

A total of Rs. 14,350 was collected using which the below mentioned items were purchased and a few of the items were directly dropped into the donation boxes as well:


Students' council activity: Ganesha Chaturti
